Cope with memories of war or trauma

20% of today's troops are diagnosed with Traumatic Brain Injury or Post Traumatic Stress. Some will need help today, others in a decade. With help from donors like you, Veterans Outreach Center will continue to provide supportive services and counseling.

Achieve personal and career goals

Veterans need help to translate their military skills into the civilian job market. Some need new skills. With the best counselors, a network of hundreds of hiring employers, and access to 19 area technical schools and colleges, Veterans Outreach Center helps veterans find the right training program and/or job to help them maintain their independence and pride.

Adjust to civilian life

The whole family feels the strain of a deployment and may struggle to return to 'normal' life. To ease this transition for veterans and their families, Veterans Outreach Center provides help with:

Peer Mentoring, Housing, Financial Literacy, Benefits Counseling, Educational Counseling, Employment Services, Emotional Distress, Legal Affair, Creative Art Therapy, Readjustment Counseling, Alcohol & Substance Abuse Counseling and Referral Services.

The VOC helps 1,000+ veterans each year:

400 are placed in good-paying jobs and so they can support their families. 100 veterans in crisis are given safe emergency shelter until they get back on their feet; 600 are helped to secure safe and affordable housing. 700 are provided financial counseling or free tax services. And hundreds receive support to reduce depression, guilt, anxiety, and, for some, thoughts of suicide.
